

What do I need to do to qualify to compete in the State Charter School Spelling Bee?

*Each school can enter 2 students in the 3rd-5th grade division and 2 students in the 6th-8th grade division.

1. Hold class spelling bees at your school. Follow the state spelling bee rules. The winner and runner up from each class bee qualifies to compete in the school bee.
2. Hold 2 school spelling bees. Follow the state spelling bee rules. At the school level two bees will be conducted; the 3rd-5th grade school bee and the 6th-8th grade school bee.
The 3rd-5th grade division school bee consists of the winners and runner-ups from the 3rd-5th grade class bees.
The 6th-8th grade division school bee consists of the winners and runner-ups from the 6th-8th grade class bees.
The winner and runner-up from the 3rd-5th grade school spelling bee and the winner and runner-up from the 6th-8th grade school spelling bee qualify to compete in the State Charter School Spelling Bee.
